He had already started coming to my house to study more English, so I asked him if he would like to study the Bible together. Since the semester started, he has been coming once a week to study a short book of Bible lessons in English and Tibetan. The first few lessons are from Genesis before moving to the New Testament. After each lesson, without my prompting, he gives a short summary. This week he said, “God made people. God rested on the seventh day. God is good.” Yes, yes, He is! Another question asked, “What is God like?” Roy answered, “God flies.” I was perplexed where this answer came from before I remembered we had studied Genesis 1 a few weeks ago, and it says, “The Spirit of God was hovering over the waters...” Please pray for Roy to see clearly who God is and for the Holy Spirit to open his mind and heart as he studies.
